Thus, as of 03/17/1999, the Academic Records Division of the General Secretariat of USP began to require that the copy of the undergraduate degree be recorded.

The enrollment of graduates in a Short Course: Short Degree, Operational Engineering, Theology, etc. is not allowed.

NOTE: For enrollment in the selection process for Postgraduate Courses (Master's and Doctorate), the student may apply without an advisor. However, **REGISTRATION** will only be accepted by the Graduate Department, together with the registration form and acceptance letter from the advisor, previously accredited by CPG and able to assume the advice.
